



## Honoring Mary, Our Mother

It is a long-standing Catholic tradition to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary during the month of May in our homes and with a May Crowning using a crown made of blossoms to signify her Queenship as the Mother of Christ the King. We invite all parishioners to participate in the following:

- **Saturday, May 2, after 11:00 am**  
View the crowning of Mary on the St. George YouTube channel.
- **Saturday, May 2, 12:00pm to 7:00pm & Sunday, May 3, 12:00pm to 6:00pm**  
Visit the Marian Garden outside the St. George Chapel to honor the Blessed Mother by placing flowers at the feet of Mary.  
*PLEASE NOTE: It is very important that social distancing and respect for one another be maintained during this prayerful event. This is not a social gathering. When you arrive, please follow directions for approaching the statue of the Blessed Mother.*
- **Throughout the month of May**  
Continue to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary. Create an altar or prayer corner in your home honoring the Blessed Mother. To help you enter into prayer, a rosary, an image of Mary, a Bible and/or a Marian book might be placed on your altar.
